11h00 - Arriving in Braga

Braga is the oldest town in Portugal and one of the oldest Christian cities in the world. Founded in the Roman times under the name of Bracara Augusta, the city has more than 2000 years of history. It was the headquarters of the Portuguese bishopric in the XII century, and it is probably the main religious center in the country, known for its baroque churches, magnificent 18th century houses and elaborate gardens and squares. Braga is a place where the old blends with the new. Walk around the city streets, explore the Arcada (city's downtown) and discover all the entertainment, the bars, cafés and shops.







11h30 - Visit to Bom Jesus followed by lunch

This spiritual sanctuary is considered one of the most beautiful in Portugal. Surrounded by magnificent gardens, the neoclassical church was designed by Carlos Amarante in the late 18th century. The famous baroque stairway zigzags up to the church, featuring enchanting fountains and statues along the way. Visitors can also take the funicular (hydraulic cable car) or drive to the top to enjoy the peaceful ambience and outstanding views.











14h00 - Departure to Guimaraes

14h30 - Visit Historical Center

Declared World Heritage by UNESCO, Guimarães adds this award to another title it displays by right, the cradle of the nation as a proud and dominating castle was born in the twelfth century, the first king of Portugal D. Afonso Henriques. The distinguished historical center is extremely well preserved and the narrow streets of the Medieval Town, with old houses embellished by ornate balconies and statuary, leading to the beautiful Largo da Oliveira, one of the centers of interest. Guimarães was proudly the European Capital of Culture of 2012.







15h30 – Workshop Creative Tourism Guimarães

18h00 - Check-in and dinner at Pousada de Guimarães - Sta. Marinha

Situated in a 12th century Augustin Convent, the Pousada Mosteiro de Guimaraes overlooks Guimarães. Rooms are equipped with modern amenities. Each of the individually decorated rooms are located in what used to be cloisters.

09h00 - Departure to Ponte de Lima

10h00 - Visit the Historical Center

Ponte de Lima is located on the south side of the Lima River and is one of the oldest cities in Portugal (founded in 1125), and historically important as a Roman settlement on the road from Braga to Santiago de Compostela. In the center of a rich agricultural region, where the famous Vinho Verde is produced, the rural area around it has the largest concentration of baroque mansions in Portugal, some of them offering tourist accommodation.







12h00 - Visit and lunch at Terra Rosa Country House

Terra Rosa Country House & Vineyards is the name of the agritourism that carries in itself the heart of Minho. Located in "Quinta de Codeçosa", a family estate, dating back to 1758, between Ponte de Lima and Vila Verde, seventy hectares of a unique atmosphere are home to fifty hectares of vineyards. A main house organizes, along with other buildings, a space of comfort and tranquillity, from which you enjoy a surrounding and unique landscape. And all this is accessed by an elegant cypress-lined entrance, between vineyards rigorously traced and laid out. Welcome to our home.











14h00 - Departure to Caminha and Visit the Historical Center

Caminha, formerly known as a fishing village, was once a land of smugglers, has kept the peace of mind and a taste for past times, summoning a sentimental nostalgia through its small streets, cafés, and restaurants where you can taste the local cuisine, fish and the freshest seafood, enjoy the old buildings, and mingle with kind and smiling people.







15h30 – Departure to Viana do Castelo

Viana do Castelo is the Atlantic city further north of Portugal. This city is like a living museum, with countless monuments and mansions of different periods and styles. Viana do Castelo is a city where visitors can enjoy a remarkable quality of life where the presence of the river, the mountain and the sea gives this city its wonderful facets.







16h30 – Visit Pousada de Viana do Castelo – Monte de Sta. Luzia

The Pousada de Viana do Castelo, Santa Luzia, built in 1918, is fruit of the remodelling of the old Santa Luzia Hotel, maintaining the impressive characteristics which set it apart with the high majestic granite walls and the wide archways. A few hundred metres from the city stands the Mount Santa Luzia, dominating the metropolis and the Lima estuary up the Atlantic, where our eyes are fed by the luxurious panorama.











18h30 - Check and dinner at FeelViana

The FeelViana Hotel preserves and respects the exceptional habitat where it is set, by using natural building materials, such as wood, for a sober and harmonious integration in the vast pinewood forest where it is located.
